Record of Proceedings

Learned counsel for CTUIL pointed out that the Petitioner has not mapped CTUIL as a Respondent in the e-filing portal of the Commission, because of which CTUIL could not file the reply in the matter. The Commission directed the Petitioner to submit the period of mismatch along with the corresponding capacity in respect of all its three generating units on affidavit by 30.7.2023, with a copy to the Respondents. The Commission also directed the Respondents to file a reply, on affidavit, by 15.8.2023, with an advance copy to the Petitioner, who may file its rejoinder, if any, by 31.8.2023.



4. The petition shall be listed for a final hearing on 13.9.2023.
