

CENTRAL ELECTRICITY REGULATORY COMMISSION

CIRCULAR dated 11 September, 2023

Empanelment of consulting firm/institutions for Assisting the Commission in Discharging its various Regulatory functions.

1. CERC vide public notice dated 28 April, 2023, invited applications from experienced, technically qualified and professionally managed Consultancy Firms/Institutions for empanelment through a Public Notice.
2. A Consultancy Evaluation Committee (CEC) was set up to consider the proposals received from various Consultancy Firms/Institutions for assisting the Commission in discharging its various regulatory functions in response to Notice dated 28.04.2023. CEC evaluated and scrutinized the technical bids.
3. Based on recommendations of CEC, competent authority has approved to empanel following 5 (five) agencies for assisting the Commission in discharging its various regulatory functions:

4. The validity of above panel shall be for one year from the date of issue of this circular. Validity is extendable by one-year subject to satisfactory performance.
5. CERC reserved the right at its discretion to add/delete any agency.
6. All the terms and conditions of the Call for Expression of Interest (EOI) shall be adhered to by the above empanelled consulting firm.
7. The above empanelled agencies would become eligible to bid for carrying out the work/projects as and when required by CERC.
8. At the end of the validity period of empanelment, the empanelled agencies may apply afresh for the same. This issue with the approval of the Competent Authority.
