3. The Commission further directed the Petitioner to submit the purpose of construction

of Asset-6 and Asset-7 and the Power Supply Agreement between the Petitioner and Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Limited, if any, by 3.3.2024 with a copy to all the Respondents.
